

Waste Concentration Game

Instructions: Use this deck to test your memory with a game of concentration!

Print out the grid below and cut out all the waste icons to create a deck with two of each icon. Turn them over so you can't see the pictures, and shuffle the deck. Lay out the cards in 4 lines of 4. To play, start by flipping over two cards. Do they match? If not, flip them back over and try again. If they do match, remove the cards from the deck and give yourself a point! See how quickly you can find all the pairs.

To play with a partner, take turns flipping over cards. Whoever gets the most pairs is the winner!



DOWN:

- 1. A set of signal lights used to control traffic at intersections.
- 2. This is an orange cone marker that directs traffic away from road workers.
- 3. This is the colour on the signal light that means go.
- 4. The colour that means stop.
- 5. A lane marked on the street where people can cross safely.
- 8. The colour on a signal light that means yield (approach with caution).

ACROSS:

- 5. The part of the walk signal that tells you how much time you have to cross the road safely.
- 6. Holes formed in the pavement.
- 7. This is an area for passengers to get on and off the bus.
- 9. A posted sign that tells you how fast you can drive.
- 10. A person who travels on foot.




