- Can you locate a water tower in your neighbourhood, city or town?

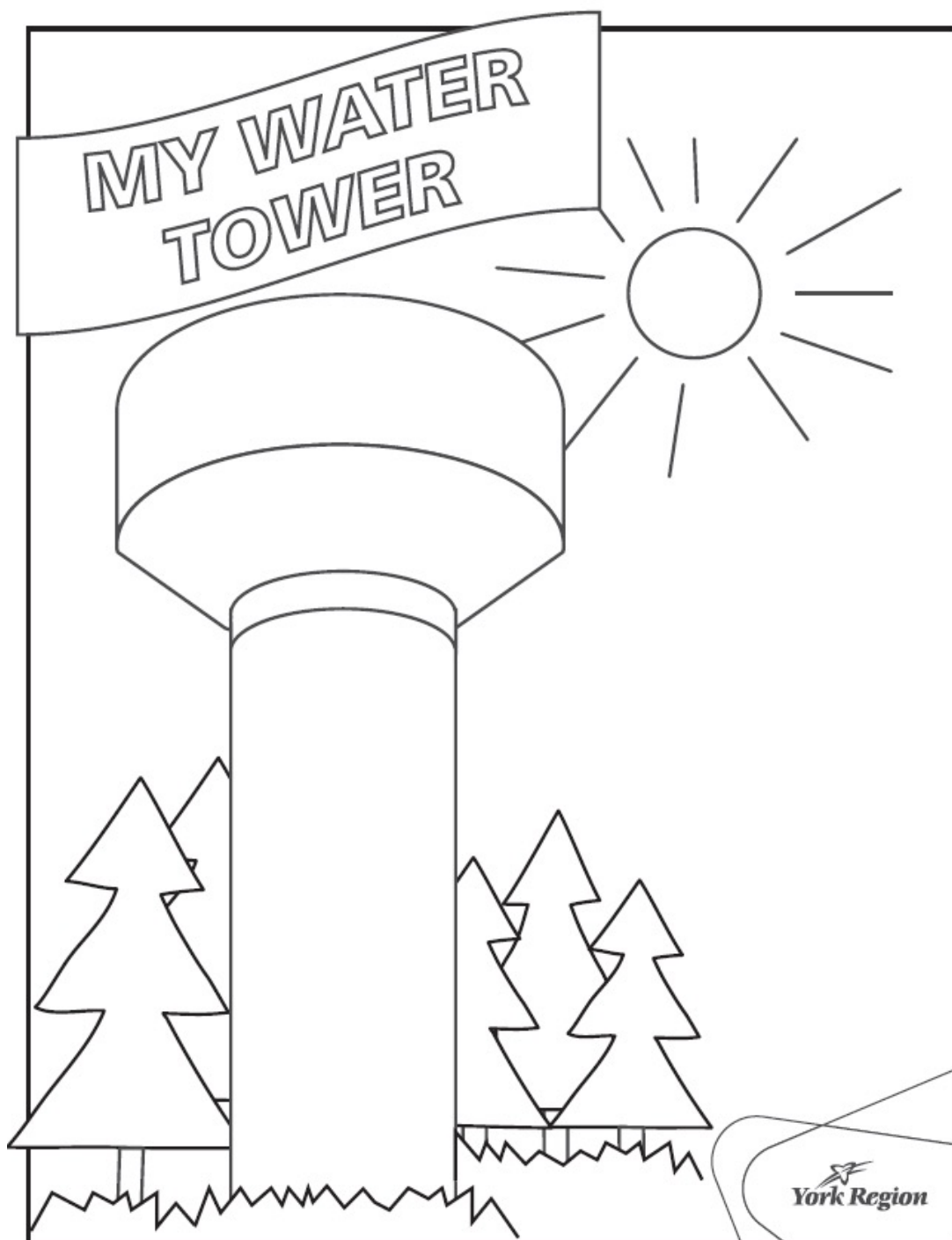
## Water Tower Activity
