What are examples of items that you should not flush?

What items are okay to flush?

• #1 (pee), #2 (poo), toilet paper – that's it!

What could happen if you flush things that shouldn't go down the drain?

- Expensive repairs
- Floods or wastewater back-ups into your home
- Clogs in the toilets and pipes
- Service disruptions
- Damage pipes and machinery at the treatment plants
- Overflow or spills into rivers and lakes
