- Intermediate level and/or high-level disinfectants were not available on site for the reprocessing of reusable non-critical and semi-critical manicure and pedicure equipment/tools.
- Single-use equipment was not being discarded after use.
- Hand hygiene sink was not dedicated for hand hygiene purposes only.

- Use disinfectants for the reprocessing of reusable equipment/devices that have a Drug Identification Number (DIN), Natural Product Number (NPN), and/or Medical Device License (MDAL) with Health Canada (with exception of Chlorine Bleach).
- Ensure disinfectants have efficacy claims to achieve intermediate and/or high- level disinfection.
- Use disinfectants within the expiry date.
- Dedicate and use at least one sink, which is used only for hand hygiene.
- Discard single-use equipment immediately after use.
