

Temporary Road Closure

Northeast Vaughan Water Servicing: Phase One

York Region is building two new water pumping stations, including an elevated water tank and a 3.2 kilometre watermain to provide water service to the northeast Vaughan area.

DESCRIPTION

Jane Street, between King-Vaughan Road and Kirby Road, will be temporarily closed to install a watermain.

DURATION

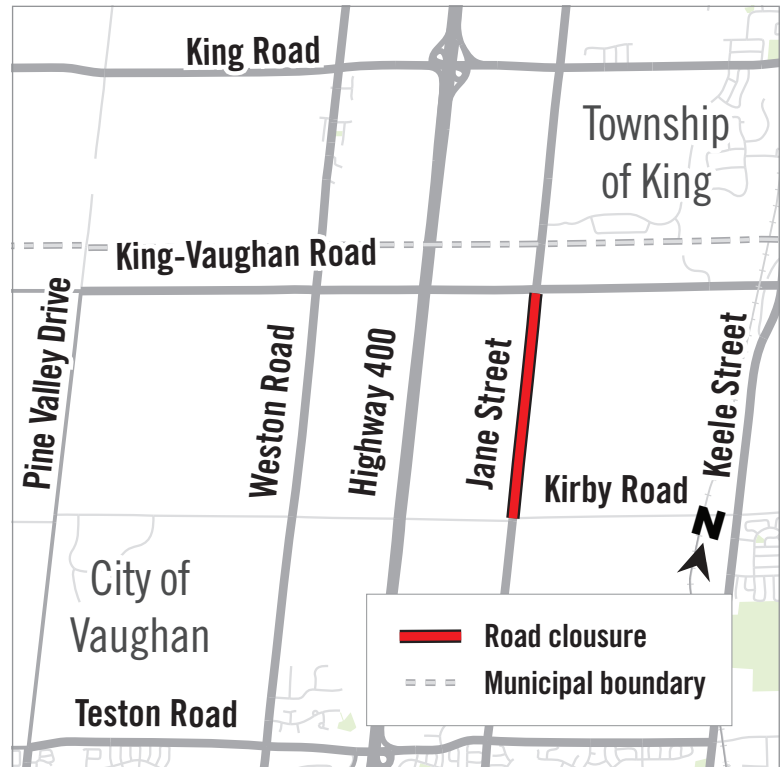

IMPACTS TO TRAVELLERS

- Signs will be in place to guide travellers
- Local traffic will be maintained
