CONTEST DURATION

HOW TO ENTER

During the Contest Period, a Contestant entering the Contest must complete the survey as described in sections 1 or 2 below ("Entry" or "Entries").

1. Completing an online survey by visiting york.ca/WasteDepots, following the "Take the Survey" instructions to submit the online survey form, and completing the online ballot available at the end of the completed survey, which includes providing the Contestant's first and last name, telephone number, and postal code; or
2. Calling Access York at 1-877-665-6752 to request an alternative survey format or to receive a Contest Entry which includes providing the Contestant's first and last name, telephone number, and postal code

Each time a Contestant makes a submission through the online form or by calling Access York, whether or not the submission constitutes an Entry, the Contestant is agreeing to comply with these Official Contest Rules and Regulations. All submittals that comply with these Official Contest Rules and Regulations, as determined by York Region, constitute Entries.

No purchase is necessary to enter the Contest. Contestants are not required to answer every question, or any question, in the survey for their Contest Entry to be accepted.

reimbursements will be given for these amounts by York Region. Prize winners are also responsible for monitoring any corresponding expiry dates of the gift cards.

PRIZE WINNER SELECTIONS AND NOTIFICATION

The Contest draws will take place on the following dates:

- February 23, 2026, at 12:00 p.m. ET;
- April 27, 2026, at 12:00 p.m. ET;

The odds of winning depend on the number of valid Entries received.
