- Reusable equipment used in the provision of manicure services (cuticle pushers, scissors, nippers, tweezers, and metal/diamond drill bits) was not cleaned and disinfected as often as necessary to prevent disease transmission.
- Reusable equipment was not cleaned manually using detergent and water or mechanically using an ultrasonic cleaner or a washer-disinfector.
- Reusable equipment was not disinfected for the required contact time to ensure effective elimination of microorganisms.
