- Reprocessing area used for cleaning and disinfection of reusable manicure and pedicure tools was not designated or designed to prevent cross-contamination.
- Reusable tools used for manicure and pedicure were not cleaned manually using detergent or enzymatic cleaner and water or mechanically using an ultrasonic cleaner or a washer-disinfector.
- Reusable tools used for manicure and pedicure were not disinfected using a disinfectant solution that was appropriate for the intended use of the tools, nor prepared according to the Manufacturer's Instructions for Use (MIFU).
