### Report of the General Manager Summer Recess Contract Award

### 1. Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board receive this report for information.

### 2. Purpose

Section 6.15 of the Housing York Inc. Purchasing Bylaw, authorizes the President to award any contract during summer recess when regular Board or Shareholder meetings are suspended. As required under Section 6.16 of the Housing York Inc. Purchasing Bylaw, this report advises the Board of the contract awarded under this authority during the 2017 summer recess.

### 3. Background

# The Purchasing By-law requires reporting of contract awards made during summer recess

The Purchasing By-law indicates that;

- Despite any other provision of this bylaw, during any period that regular Board or Shareholder meetings are suspended either during a summer recess or for any other reason, or during the period that the acts of the Shareholder are restricted under Section 275 of the *Municipal Act, 2001,* the President shall be authorized to award any contract.
- A report shall be submitted to the Board as soon as reasonably possible setting out the details of any contract awarded under this authority.

## 4. Analysis and Implications
