**RE: Township of King
Engineering, Public Works and Building Department Report No.: EPW-2017-24
Traffic Signals on Dufferin Street between King Road and the 15th Sideroad – Request by
Country Day School**

At its meeting of July 10, 2017, Council received Engineering, Public Works and Building Department Report No. EPW-2017-24 regarding the installation of traffic signals on Dufferin Street between King Road and the 15th Sideroad in King City, and the following Resolution was passed, as follows:

"WHEREAS on numerous occasions the Region of York has been informed of the concerns expressed by Country Day School regarding the need for a Traffic Signal being added on Dufferin Street between King Road and the 15th Sideroad, at the main entrance for Country Day School;

WHEREAS the Region of York advised that Dufferin Street between King Road and the 15th Sideroad, at the main entrance for Country Day School did not satisfy the minimum criteria required by the York Region's Traffic Signal Policy;

WHEREAS the Region of York requires the cost of any unwarranted Traffic Signal to be paid by the proponent, Country Day School;

THEREFORE BE IT RECOMMENDED that the Township of King in support of Country Day School's request, forward the adopted Resolution to the Region of York to request that the proposed Traffic Signals to be located on Dufferin Street between King Road and the 15th Sideroad, at the main entrance for Country Day School, be installed immediately;

AND THAT should the installation of traffic signals referenced above be approved by the Region of York, that all associated costs for the traffic signals be paid for by Country Day School as stated in their letter dated June 19, 2017 attached hereto."

Re: Installation of Traffic Signals on Dufferin Street

At a Town Council meeting last year, it seemed that the issue of a traffic light on Dufferin, at our main entrance would be solved through the routing of a residential road directly across from our property. Having attended a few of the recent environmental meetings with respect to the development planned for the west side of Dufferin, I understand that the road, and the light, has been moved north.

I recently met with Nelson Costa, Manager of Traffic Safety for York Region to discuss the implementation of traffic signals on Dufferin Street at the Main Entrance to The Country Day School -- at our own expense. These signals will greatly improve the safe entry and exiting of a significant number of vehicles at morning drop off and afternoon pick up. Nelson was very positive regarding the installation, possibly next year. We are aware that CDS will fund the entire cost of this installation.

The Country Day School respectfully requests your assistance in presenting a motion to King Township Council that a formal request be made to York Region for the installation of these traffic signals.

I would be pleased to discuss this with you further should you have any questions. Thanking you in advance for your kind assistance.
