Richmond Hill Town Council, at its meeting held on February 27, 2017, adopted the following resolution:

Whereas on many occasions the Region of York has been informed of the concerns expressed by residents regarding the need for a Traffic Signal being added at the intersection of Dariole Drive and Bayview Avenue;

Whereas the Region of York advised multiple times that the intersection did not satisfy the minimum criteria required by the York Region's Traffic Signal Policy;

Whereas the Region of York recently stated this year that the intersection of Dariole Drive and Bayview Avenue does now satisfy the requirements of the policy and a traffic signal would be "tentatively" scheduled for installation in 2017;

Whereas approximately 65 area residents signed a petition requesting that a traffic signal be installed immediately;

Therefore Be It Recommended that the Town of Richmond Hill forward the petition received from residents to the Region of York to request that the Traffic Signal located at Dariole Drive and Bayview Avenue be installed immediately.
