

THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF YORK

BYLAW NO. 2017-3

To acquire certain lands for or in connection with the construction of the proposed Water Reclamation Centre,
Town of East Gwillimbury

WHEREAS the Council of The Regional Municipality of York on September 22, 2016, by its adoption of Clause 11 of Report 13 of the Committee of the Whole authorized an application for approval to expropriate the lands therein referred to for or in connection with the construction of the proposed Water Reclamation Centre on the east side of 2nd Concession Road approximately one kilometre north of Queensville Sideroad (YR 77), in the Town of East Gwillimbury; and

WHEREAS Notice of Application for Approval to Expropriate Land has been served upon the registered owners of the lands and has been published pursuant to the provisions of the *Expropriations Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. E.26, as amended (the "Act"); and

WHEREAS no notification of a desire for a hearing has been received and the time for giving such notification has expired; and

WHEREAS the Council of The Regional Municipality of York on January 26, 2017, by its adoption of Clause 22 of Report 1 of the Committee of the Whole approved the expropriation of the hereinafter described lands.

Now, therefore, the Council of The Regional Municipality of York
HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The expropriation of the lands referred to in section 3 is hereby approved for or in connection with the construction of the proposed Water Reclamation Centre on the east side of 2nd Concession Road approximately one kilometre north of Queensville Sideroad (YR 77), in the Town of East Gwillimbury.
2. The Regional Chair and Regional Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute a Certificate of Approval pursuant to the Act.
3. The Region, as expropriating authority, expropriate the following lands, by the preparation, execution and registration of a plan of expropriation:
Fee Simple Interest:
Parts 1 to 16, both inclusive, on Plan 65R-35610
4. The Commissioner of Corporate Services is authorized to cause the said plan or plans to be registered in the proper Land Registry Office, to give notice of such expropriation in accordance with the Act and to execute all necessary documents to effect the transaction.
5. Plan No. 65R-35610, hereto attached, shall form part of this bylaw.
