RE: Holland Landing Sewage Treatment Plant and Lagoon System

Dear Denis Kelly:

For your information and records, at its regular meeting held on July 19, 2016 the Council of the Town of East Gwillimbury enacted as follows:

WHEREAS Town Council endorsed and issued a resolution regarding the Holland Landing Sewage Treatment Plant and Iagoon system to the Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change (MOECC) on May 3, 2016; and

WHEREAS the MOECC provided a response to the Town dated June 8, 2016; and

WHEREAS Town Council wishes to clarify that its concerns relate to the timely and expeditious diversion of flows from the Holland Landing Sewage Treatment Plant and Iagoon system; and

WHEREAS the Region of York has established sufficient reserve capacity in the YDSS to accommodate the flows, in full, from the Holland Landing Sewage Treatment Plant and Iagoon system.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT the Region of York exercise its option to divert flows from the Holland Landing Sewage Treatment Plant and lagoon system once the system has a physical connection to the YDSS in place; and

THAT the diversion of flows from the Holland Landing Sewage Treatment Plant and lagoon system to the YDSS coincide with the commissioning of the 2nd Concession Sanitary Linear Works currently nearing completion; and

THAT the formal decommissioning of the Holland Landing Lagoons be coordinated with the Region once the Water Reclamation Centre is approved; and

THAT Council direct staff to forward a copy of this resolution to York Region and the MOECC.
