



Pricing

Keynote

Introductory education through an inspiring presentation to key decision-makers followed by Q&A. From **US\$5,000**.

Master Class

Offsite preparation, onsite workshop leadership, with local meetings, social events and press interviews. U**\$\$10,000.**

Metrics

Analysis of data submitted by the community, using ICF's proprietary analytic tools, including submission of the written report. Onsite presentation of the report is available for an extra per-diem charge. **US\$15,000**

Mentoring

Offsite preparation, onsite and remote meeting facilitation over extended period. Price varies depending on duration and scope. Average annual cost: **US\$25,000**.

The Community Accelerator is priced as shown above. Travel expenses for onsite participation are additional at net cost.



Additional Option: ICF Immersion Labs

Upon request, ICF can provide familiarization tours/ immersion labs of targeted Intelligent Communities to give key stakeholders a first-hand look at their strategies, programs and successes.
