I write to advise you that Vaughan Council at its meeting held on December 15, 2015, adopted the following resolution:

York Region's senior population is growing. It is important to support the health and well-being of seniors in York Region so they can lead healthy, active lives and stay involved in their communities. One way to do this is to provide seniors with more affordable transit options.

Whereas, seniors have made significant contributions to our community and it is important to recognize this contribution

Whereas, many seniors in our community live on a fixed income

Whereas, York Region has established a Seniors Advisory Task Force of Council to explore opportunities to improve support to seniors

Whereas, municipalities in the Greater Toronto and Hamilton Area such as Oakville, Mississauga and Hamilton are offering further discounts or free transit to seniors during select days/times of the week
