

Subject: Leslie Street concerns

Tara,

As per our conversation, here are some concerns that need to be addressed ASAP and should be able to be implemented immediately:

- 1. speed signs on Leslie NB that are further south than the one near the school there is no signage announcing the start of the new 50 zone............
- 2. signs announcing a school zone both NB and SB the one that is currently on the NB side is inadequate
- 3. flashing light signs (as seen in Holland Landing) announcing a school zone at that when flashing, speed is to be reduced (before and after school)

In addition to these items, we are looking for a definitive answer that the sidewalk and shoulder will be restored ASAP to the new traffic light.

I am sending this email as a parent to provide further support to the incredible work our school council is doing. I understand some of the road changes require research etc however the simple signage I am requesting here should be a simple issue and one that should be identified as a TOP priority - surely nothing is more important than the safety of our school children.

Thank you - I await your response and I also look forward to hearing from Ms Hackson both in her capacity as Mayor and in her Regional role.
