BYLAW NO. 2014-23

A bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 2011-56 to regulate discharge of sewage, storm water and land drainage

WHEREAS on November 17, 2011, Regional Council enacted Bylaw No. 2011-56 to regulate the discharge of sewage, storm water and land drainage in the Regional Municipality of York;

AND WHEREAS Bylaw No. 2011-56 was amended by Bylaw No. 2012-70 on October 18, 2012 to defer implementation of the prohibition on food waste grinders contained in Part 17 of the bylaw for further consideration by the Food Waste Grinder Sub-Committee;

AND WHEREAS Regional Council wishes to amend Bylaw No. 2011-56 to remove the prohibition on food waste grinders under Part 17, as amended by Bylaw No. 2012-70 and to effect administrative changes;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Regional Municipality of York hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. Bylaw No. 2011-56 (the "Bylaw"), as amended by Bylaw No. 2012-70, is hereby amended as set out in this bylaw.
- 2. Section 1.1 of the Bylaw is amended by deleting the following:
 - t) "food waste grinder" includes a device for the purposes of macerating or grinding garbage and/or food wastes;
- 3. Part 17 of the Bylaw is repealed in its entirety.
- 4. Section 24.8 of the Bylaw is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 - 24.8. A demand by an enforcement officer to respond to reasonable inquiries under section 24.7(e) or to produce documents or things under section 24.7(f) may be made by telephone, letter or e-mail and such demand shall be deemed to be made in the course of an inspection.
- 5. The Bylaw is amended by adding the following:

29. SHORT TITLE

29.1. The short title of this bylaw is the "Sewer Use Bylaw".
