

## **Processing of Publicly-Funded Vaccine Orders to Resume**

### **Update to York Region health care providers as of January 7, 2022**

York Region Public Health Vaccine Inventory program will now resume with the processing of publicly-funded vaccine orders, including DTaP-IPV-Hib, Tdap, Tdap-IPV, Td, IPV, Hib, Pneu-C-13, Pneu-P-23, MMR, MMRV, Var, Rot-1, 4CMenB, Men-C-C, Men-C-ACYW, HA, HB, HPV-9, HZ, and Influenza.

We thank you for your patience as we refocused our efforts to aid in the ramp-up of COVID-19 mass immunization clinic sites and facilitate increased primary care provider access to COVID-19 vaccines due to the COVID-19 Omicron variant.

Vaccine order forms are posted on [york.ca/vaccineinventory](http://york.ca/vaccineinventory). Please allow a minimum of five business days for processing at this time. You will receive a notification by telephone call or e-mail when your vaccine order is ready for pick-up.
