

Vaccine Pick Up/Drop Off Times: UPDATE for Vaughan and Richmond Hill

Update to York Region health care providers as of February 26, 2021

As York Region Public Health's response to the COVID-19 pandemic progresses, we are adapting our program and service delivery. Effective March 1, 2021, our vaccine pick-up and drop-off locations will adjust their available hours.

Due to current public health measures and organizational requirements, our locations continue to be open for a number of time periods throughout the day, rather than a fully restored schedule. Please see the table below for hours of availability for vaccine pick up and wastage drop off at each of our vaccine distribution locations. The table also includes the phone number and extension to call at each location when you arrive.

We hope these modified times will provide some flexibility and convenience for health professionals in York Region.

Please note that public access to most York Region buildings is restricted at this time. When you visit a vaccine location, special procedures will still be in place due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic:

1. Health professionals, or their designate, who are picking up vaccine orders should call the reception desk when they arrive. A sign will be posted at the main entrance that will indicate what phone number and extension you should call (also noted above).
2. When you call the extension, a York Region staff member will ask for your premise's name and holding point code. To better serve you,

please have your holding point code available. Your holding point code can be found on your cooler, your vaccine fridge, and temperature logbook.

3. Due to the temperature sensitivity of vaccines, a York Region staff member will verify that your transport cooler is in the correct temperature range (between +2.0°C and +8.0°C) before you can receive your vaccine order. Please ensure your cooler has the proper equipment (i.e., digital thermometer, ice packs, fridge blankets, and bubble wrap) and is pre-conditioned between +2.0°C and +8.0°C upon arrival at your designated pick-up location.
4. Once your transport cooler's temperature has been verified to be in temperature range, York Region staff will bring your vaccine order to you. Please maintain physical distancing of 2 metres or more at all times during the pick-up process.
