Guide for Regional Roads

Executive Summary

This Election Sign Guide outlines the criteria set out in York Region's Sign Bylaw. York Region's Sign Bylaw No. 2015-36 was enacted by York Regional Council on September 21, 2006 and amended on June 26, 2015. This bylaw regulates the sign placement, duration and specifications on Regional roads.

This document applies to election signs on Regional roads only. For bylaws relating to local roads, please consult your local municipality.

Registration

A non-refundable Election Sign Permit fee may be applied per candidate per local municipality in which candidates or third party advertisers seek to install signs. The fee is payable to the local municipality.

Sign Size

Signs must be in proper repair and not exceed 1.22 metres (4 feet) high and 1.22 metres (4 feet) wide.

Sign Placement

Reference page (4) for a sign restriction diagram

- Signs are only permitted at intersections on Regional roads
- Signs are permitted within 40 metres (131 feet) from the edge of the pavement of the intersecting road (10 metres less than the sign bylaw to prevent the need to measure from the centre line)
- No candidate, registered third party or registered third party advertiser shall place more than two signs per intersection (one per corner) at permitted Regional intersections
- The candidate is responsible to ensure all precautions are taken to avoid damage to existing utilities and objects in the road right of way


Signs cannot be placed:

- At any restricted intersections due to property constraints (see the sign restriction maps in the maps section)
- In a location that impairs or obstructs the visibility of motorists or pedestrians or warning devices including railway, traffic or municipal signs
- On any centre median, traffic island or centre boulevard within a road allowance
- Within five metres (17 feet) from a fire hydrant, transit shelter or bus stop
- Within three metres (10 feet) lateral distance from the edge of the road pavement or back of curb
- Within ten metres (33 feet) lateral distance from intersection or driveway pavement edge

If sign placement does not comply with the bylaw, signs will be removed for public safety.

Placement Restriction Diagram


Signs are only permitted at intersections on Regional roads as outlined below. NOTE: NOT TO SCALE

Installation and Removal of Signs

- Installation and removal of signs is the responsibility of election candidates
- Election signs are permitted 24 hours per day, seven days per week only during the period commencing at 10 a.m. on the 28th day prior election day
- 72 hours following the close of the polls all signs must be removed from the Regional road intersections
- Signs placed in contrary to York Region's Sign Bylaw will be removed by York Region and/or local municipal staff
- Signs that are removed will be held until after election day



Safety Precautions


When installing/removing election signs, take proper safety precautions to ensure your safety and the safety of the public, including reducing driver distractions. Safety tips include:

- All persons working near roadways shall wear reflective vests/bright clothing and safety footwear
- Signs should be installed and removed between 9:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m., outside of peak travel times
- Vehicles should be parked in such a way to minimize the impact to other motorists, pedestrians and cyclists
- A road occupancy permit will be required if any lanes are blocked. Information about road permits is available on york.ca/roadpermits
- Stay clear of any maintenance or construction operations and equipment
- Ensure signs are properly secured to avoid being blown away

Please note, only coroplast campaign signs are accepted. Plastic film signs will not be accepted. All fasteners, wood or metal stakes and wires must be removed prior to dropoff. 




Town of Aurora Sign Restricted Intersections








