



**User Rates:** Water and wastewater user fees, transit fares and advertising

**Grants & Subsidies:** Payments from provincial and federal governments to help cover program and service delivery costs

**Development Charge Reserves:** Drawn upon to cover costs of borrowing for infrastructure that supports growth

Fees, Charges & Other Reserves: Revenues collected for fines and Regional services

**Tax Levy:** The amount paid by residential and business taxpayers based on the assessed value of property in York Region
