Viva Maze

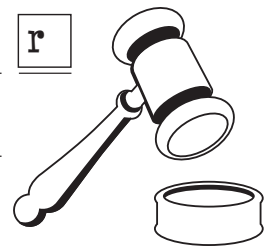

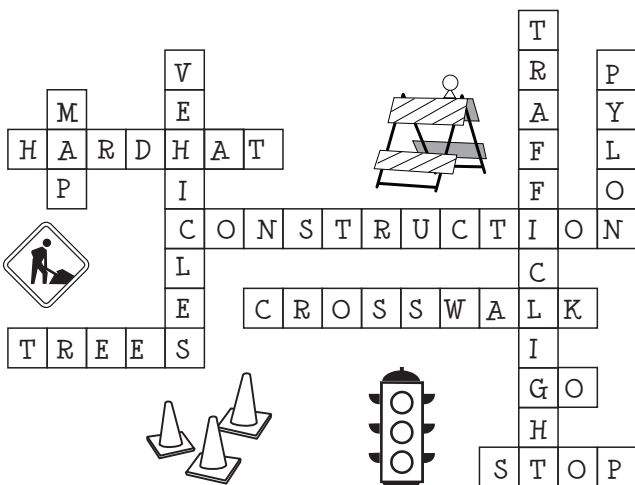

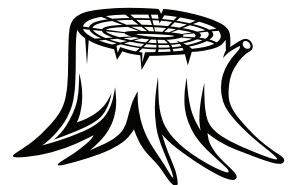
