Guest Policy

Tenants are welcome to have a guest stay in their unit for a period of up to fourteen days.

However, a tenant must request in writing to the Property Manager for a guest to stay longer than fourteen days. The request will include the guest's name, the number of days and the reason for request.

Property Managers will provide their decision in writing to the tenant.

Tenants are responsible for their guest's behaviour and their treatment of Housing York Inc. property.

Guests will be asked to leave if either the quiet enjoyment of other tenants has been disturbed or there is property damage caused by the guest.

Guests who stay longer than the date approved by the Property Manager will be considered unauthorized occupants. The guests must leave the unit. A RGI tenant could lose their rental subsidy if their guest does not leave.

Boarders and lodgers are not permitted in any unit under any circumstances.
