


Alcohol Use: Underage drinkers

<u>Indicator</u>: Proportion of secondary students (grades 9-12) who reported drinking alcohol in the past year. <u>Data Source</u>: Ontario Student Drug Use and Health Survey (OSDUHS)

Key Findings

- In 2015, 58 (±9) per cent of York Region students (grades 9-12) reported drinking alcohol in the past year, which was similar to their Ontario counterparts.
- Females and males were equally likely to drink alcohol in the past year (data not shown).
- Grade 9 students were less likely to drink alcohol in the past year compared to their counterparts in other grades (data not shown).
