


NOTICE OF STUDY COMMENCEMENT

Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Study

Elgin Mills Road/CN Rail Crossing from Yonge Street to East of Newkirk Road

in the City of Richmond Hill

The Regional Municipality of York is conducting a Schedule 'C' Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) Study for improvements to Elgin Mills Road between Yonge Street and East of Newkirk Road in the City of Richmond Hill.



York Region's 2016 Transportation

Master Plan recommended eliminating the level crossing, allowing road traffic to pass over or under train traffic on Elgin Mills Road at the Canadian National Railway (CNR) corridor- Richmond Hill GO Rail line crossing. Phases 1 and 2 of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment process were completed through the TMP.

This Class EA study will reconfirm the need to enhance Elgin Mills Road and determine the preferred design for improvements, including a separation of the roadway and train tracks at the current rail crossing.

Public consultation is an important part of the EA process and York Region welcomes resident and stakeholder feedback throughout the study.
