

SECTION 1: INTRODUCTION What are NutriSTEP® and Nutri-eSTEP?

- Validated and reliable nutrition screening questionnaires that can identify feeding, activity, weight and nutrition concerns in children ages 18 months to 5 years:
 - Toddler NutriSTEP® (paper version) and Toddler Nutri-eSTEP (online version) for ages 18 to 35 month
 - Preschooler NutriSTEP[®] (paper version) and Preschooler Nutri-eSTEP (online version) for ages 3 to 5 years
- Can be completed by a child's parent in less than 10 minutes
- Can be administered or distributed in a variety of settings including primary care offices, child care centres, schools, child and family programs and child health programs

What do the NutriSTEP® and Nutri-eSTEP questionnaires screen for?

- Food and fluid intake
- Physical growth and development/weight concerns
- Factors affecting food intake and eating behaviours such as food security and the psycho-social feeding environment
- Physical activity and sedentary behaviour (screen time)

How do parents complete the NutriSTEP® and Nutri-eSTEP questionnaires?

- The questionnaires have 17 questions that ask parents about their child's eating and activity habits. Each question has several response options. Parents choose the best response to describe their child's behaviour
 - NutriSTEP® (paper versions): Parents add up the scores for each question and receive a total nutrition
 risk score for their child either low, moderate or high risk. Note: You may wish to assist parents with
 filling in the questionnaire. NutriSTEP® comes with a parent education resource and next steps for
 families according to the child's nutrition risk, e.g., speak to a registered dietitian at Telehealth Ontario
 (at no cost)
 - Nutri-eSTEP (online version): Parents complete the questions online and get immediate personalized feedback on what is going well and how to improve eating and activity habits. The online version provides links to trusted nutrition resources including the phone number to speak to a registered dietitian at Telehealth Ontario (at no cost)

- Preschooler NutriSTEP[®] questionnaire and the accompanying parent resource How to Build a Healthy Preschooler are available in 8 languages, at no cost, from York Region Community and Health Services Department, Nutrition Services
