Ministry of Health Releases Novel Coronavirus Guidance for Primary Care Providers

Update to York Region health care providers as of January 30, 2020

Cases of the novel coronavirus (2019-nCoV) continue to increase in China, with travel-related cases reported around the world including in Toronto and Vancouver. Ontario's Ministry of Health released their **2019-nCoV Guidance for Primary Care Providers in a Community Setting** to assist primary care providers in a community setting. York Region Public Health's (YRPH) recommendations for primary care providers:

- Novel coronavirus is a reportable disease. Contact YRPH immediately if you suspect a case of 2019-nCoV at 1-877-464-9675 ext. 73588 (Monday to Friday: 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.) or 905-953-6478 after hours, before you call the lab or arrange for testing. Contact YRPH right away if you:
 - are unsure whether you can safely assess a person,
 - need support with referring to hospital for swabbing, or
 - have questions about case definitions and need for testing a patient
- **2.** Access and review the Ministry of Health's guidance document. Please note: Wuhan is the city where 2019-nCoV originated, which is located in the province of Hubei, China.
- 3. Review the updated case definition from the Ministry. Updates to the case definition are likely to be ongoing given the evolving evidence. The current case definition is accessible on the Ministry's health care provider webpage at

- **4. Be aware of the following guidance** for those individuals who were on the same flight as the confirmed cases in Toronto (China Southern Airlines Flight #CZ311 from Guangzhou, China to Toronto on January 22, 2020):
 - a. Individuals on the flight that are close contacts (i.e., sitting near the case) as well as all flight crew have been and will continue to be contacted by Public Health directly
 - b. For everyone else on the plane:
 - i. If they are well: they are to watch for signs and symptoms of acute respiratory infection.
 - ii. If they have signs and symptoms: they are to call YRPH, self-isolate and we will arrange for clinical assessment and any specimen collection needed.
 - c. If anyone that was on this flight presents to you and you have questions about confirming they were on the plane or about the guidance above, call YRPH.
- **5.** Please collect the following information from anyone you believe may meet case definition for a Person Under Investigation to help our assessment:
 - a. Travel details (dates and exact location(s) of travel)
 - b. Signs, symptoms, onset and your clinical assessment
 - c. Details for your ill patient of any contact with an individual who has been ill and visited Hubei province
 - d. Full patient demographics (including phone number)
 - e. What infection prevention and control measures have been put in place
 - f. Details of who else lives at home with this person, if possible

If you suspect a case of 2019-nCoV in your clinic, contact YRPH immediately.
