

RECREATIONAL CAMP INSPECTION REPORT

NOTIFICATION

- The medical officer of health or a public health inspector is notified of camp opening, change of premises' information and/or camp closure

CAMP SAFETY

- Inspection result is posted
- Camper/camp staff member is free of any communicable disease
- All animals are vaccinated against rabies

CAMP SAFETY PLAN

- Written camp safety plan provided to the medical officer of health or a public health inspector
- Staffing requirements are met

CAMP CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE

- Camp is maintained free from any condition that may endanger the health or safety of camper/camp staff members
- Sufficient supply of potable water
- Adequate protection against the entry, harbouring and breeding of pests
- Sanitary facilities are provided and properly maintained
- Camp is maintained in a sanitary condition
- Adequate ventilation is provided and maintained where required
- Sleeping equipment is provided and kept in sanitary condition
- Laundry facilities equipped with a constant supply of hot and cold water
- Illumination maintained during all hours of operation

WATERFRONT AREAS

- Waterfront area used for aquatic activities is adequately supervised by certified lifeguards
- Sufficient waterfront area emergency equipment provided
- Waterfront area maintained in a sanitary manner and free from hazards
- Recreational camp is maintained free from every condition that may be an immediate health hazard
