Construction Updates







The Site – 275 Woodbridge Ave.

- Project Term: May 2,
 2017 to April 30,
 2019
- Site comprises three separate legal parcels being 275
 Woodbridge Avenue, 259
 Woodbridge Avenue and 64 Abell Avenue







3 Month Look Ahead Schedule

- Demolition to be complete mid-June
- Drilling of H-Piles to commence mid-June with early July completion
- Excavation to start in early July
- Crane erection in August/September
- Concrete foundations to start late August/September













Demolition of Existing Buildings

 Demolition has begun on the three existing buildings: the former seniors residence, stacked townhomes and detached home

Construction Traffic Control Plan

 Traffic routing during demolition and construction will utilize Abell and Cheltenham as much as possible due to the large amount of traffic along Woodbridge Avenue







Environmental Management

- Attaining LEED like standards
- Recycling construction and demolition materials such as concrete, wood, bricks etc.
- Material re-use helps to reduce overall building project expense









Site Management Plan and Guiding Construction Principles

- Daily or as needed street sweeping as well as demolition dust control by use of water truck
- Utilizing flagmen for all backing trucks
- Arborist on site for any work around trees/roots
- All visitors must report to site office for safety orientation prior to being allowed on site
- Site will be fully fenced and gates secured nightly
- Certified Safety Officer on site everyday
- All work to be performed in accordance with City noise by-law (96-2006), with work only permitted between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m.
