TERMS AND CONDITIONS

PART A: Water Efficiency Equipment Replacement Incentives -General Conditions

York Region Water Efficiency Administration

1. The Water Efficiency Equipment Replacement Incentives and all portions thereof (the **Incentives**") will be administered by the Infrastructure Asset Management Branch of the Environmental Services Department of The Regional Municipality of York and its agents ("the **Region**").

Eligible Facilities

2. To be eligible for the incentives, the facility must:

- a) Be located in the Region;
- b) Have a water account administered by a local municipality;
- c) Be connected to a municipal water supply; and
- d) Be classified by the Region as an industrial, commercial, or institutional building or multi-units properties (e.g. office, retail outlet, hotel, hospital, factory, warehouse, manufacturing, government, school, multi-unit residential property operated by property management company, etc.)

Eligible Equipment

- Equipment eligible for replacement or retrofit under this incentive must:

 Be purchased and installed on the facility in the Region (equipment purchased for new construction does not qualify);
 - b) Be of similar capacity and function to equipment removed or retrofitted. Significant increases in capacity, or upgrades not directly related to elimination of once-through system, are not eligible for the rebate; and
 c) Consist of one of the following:
 - Replace water-cooled condenser with air-cooled unit at the same facility.
 - Install a new dipper well faucet that has a flow rate equal to or less than 1 gallon per minute (or 3.79 liters per minute). If the dipper well is one piece, replace the entire unit. If it is two separate pieces, replace the faucet only,
 - Replace a non-WaterSense[®] labelled pre-rinse spray valve with a WaterSense[®] labelled valve or higher efficient unit (4.8 LPM or less),
 - IV) Replace a non-WaterSense[®] labelled toilet with a WaterSense[®] labelled unit or higher efficient unit (4.8 LPF or less),
 - Replace a liquid ring dental vacuum pump with one that does not use water to create suction, or
 - VI) Equipment otherwise deemed eligible by the Region.

Acceptation of Participants

4. The Region reserves the right to accept or reject, in its sole discretion, any application or any part thereof.

5. As Regional funding and/or resources are limited, applications will be processed on a first-come-first-served basis.

General Conditions

6. At any time and for any reason, the Region may in its sole discretion refuse any or all further applications for the incentives, may extend the deadline for applications for the incentives or any other deadline, or terminate the Incentives, all in the Region's sole discretion.

7. The Applicant shall ensure at all times that any and all federal, provincial, and municipal laws and by-laws are adhered to.

8. Each Applicant must be in compliance with the Region's Sewer Use Bylaw number 2011-56 as amended or replaced.

9. Failure to meet any or all conditions of the Incentives may result in refusal or disentitlement to any rebate payment.

Disclaimer and Release

10. The Applicant hereby releases and forever discharges the Region and its officers, employees, agents and elected officials (the "Releasees") from and against any all claims, costs or demands whatsoever, that it may now or ever have against the Releasees in relation to any loss, damage or injury (including death) that may occur indirectly, directly, or consequently as a result of or arising from the installation of the Applicant's equipment, including but not limited to the work or activities in relation hereto.

Indemnity Clause

11. The Applicant shall at all times defend, indemnify and save harmless the Region, its Regional Chair, Regional Council members, employees, agents, successors and assigns (all of which are hereinafter called the "Region Indemnitees") from any and all liability against any and all manner of claims, demands, losses, cost, charges, actions and other proceedings whatsoever made or brought against, suffered by or imposed on the Region Indemnitees or their property in respect of any loss, or damage or injury (including fatal injury) to any person or property directly or indirectly arising out of, resulting from or sustained as a result of the installation of the Applicant's equipment or the performance by the Applicant of anything in furtherance of its equipment, including the installation and operation of any equipment at the Applicant's facility or anything else in relation to the rebate.

PART B: Water Efficiency Equipment Replacement Incentives -Conditions

Description

1. The incentives provides a Regional contribution to help offset the capital costs incurred by an Applicant for the replacement of the inefficient water equipment to water efficient technology that results in a long-term reduction in water consumption.

Conditions for Acceptance

 The Applicant shall include in each application for the Incentives, the equipment change with specification, equipment and installation costs, and water savings estimates.

Applicant's Responsibility

3. Each participating Applicant must provide the Region with access to their facility to verify the installation of the new equipment, technology, or process change if the Region so requests.

4. Each participating Applicant must assume all financial and other responsibility in relation to the purchase and installation of the new equipment/technology to reduce water use, including any preparatory and repair work that is required for the proper installation of this new equipment/ technology.

Proof of Compliance and Conditions for Payment

5. Payment to the Applicant (purchaser of equipment) under the Incentives will be conditional upon submission by the Applicant of original proof of purchase and installation of any new equipment/technology dated after the start date of the program.

6. Unless otherwise specified by the Region, the amount of the payment for the Incentive will be calculated based on the type of equipment as follows:

- a) Packed condensing units; i.e. walk-in Fridge/freezer, air-conditioner, will be awarded as \$1,000.00 per condenser unit;
- b) Ice Machine will be awarded as \$1,000.00 per unit;
- c) Dipper Well will be awarded as \$60.00 per unit;
- d) Pre-rinse Spray Valve will be awarded as \$25.00 per unit;
- e) Toilet will be awarded as \$100.00 per unit; and
- f) Dental Vacuum Pump will be awarded as \$1,000.00 per unit.

Unless otherwise specified by the Region, the amount of the payment for the rebate shall be a one-time payment, **up to 50%** of the cost of the new equipment to the maximum as stated above per unit to a maximum of 5 units of the same equipment per facility, or other maximum value determined by the Region.

All of the following documentation must be provided:

- a) A completed application form;
- b) Existing inefficient equipment photo(s);
- c) New water efficient equipment specification and installation photo(s);
- d) Copy of Proof of Purchase document (original invoice) clearly indicating:
 I) Business name,
 - II) Installation address and contact information of retailer and/or contractor;
 - III) Date of purchase of the new equipment or date of the upgrade , and IV) Manufacturer and model number of qualifying new equipment or
 - upgrades made.

e) Annual Water billing (If applicable).

The Region does not warrant the quality of workmanship, the suitability of the premises or the equipment for installation, or that the performance of any equipment/upgrades or its installation will be free of defects.

The Region reserves the right to alter, cancel or discontinue this incentive at any time and to reverse the rebate if the information provided by the applicant is either incorrect, or untrue, or if the Terms & Conditions of the Incentives have not been met.

Applicant must agree to onsite verification if requested by the Region, prior to approval of the rebate. The Region reserves the right to inspect the installation of new equipment installed or upgrades made. This may include an inspection of the facility to monitor and evaluate efficiency of the upgrade(s).
