

Be Spa safe Checklist

General Checklist for ALL Spa Services

The spa operates in a public location inspected by York Region Public Health

A green *Proof of Public Health Inspection* sign is posted at the spa

All work areas are well lit, clean and organized



Tools, work surfaces and equipment are in good repair (for example: no rust, cracks, etc.)

Tools, equipment and surfaces are cleaned and disinfected between each client



REMEMBER

Serious infections can be spread during

- Single-use items are thrown away between each client
- Tools and supplies are stored in a clean area (for example: in covered containers)
- Creams and lotions are used in a way that does not contaminate the original product (for example: used with a pump, no fingers in jars)
- Clean sheets, towels, robes etc. are used for each client. Paper liners are thrown out after each use
- Spa workers wash their hands before and after each client
