The Regional Municipality of York is beginning the next phase of the Islington Watermain relining project, which runs from Kipling Avenue to Steeles Avenue in the City of Vaughan. The relining work will extend the life of the watermain and reduce the risk of future water service interruptions. During the first phase of the project, approximately 1400 metres of the watermain was successfully relined. Beginning in October, the second phase of the watermain work will begin, and the project is expected to be completed by fall 2019.

What do you need to know?

- During the watermain work, Highway 7 and Islington Avenue will remain open however there will be temporary lane restrictions
- Motorists are asked to reduce their speed when driving through the construction work zone and to expect some delays
- There may be periodic water service interruptions; however, updates will be provided

YRT Transit Services
