

## Materials accepted - no charge

- Blue box recyclables
- Cooking oil\* (Tuesday and Saturday only)
- Electronic waste\*
- Household hazardous waste\*
- Large, polystyrene foam
- Refrigerated appliances with valid CFC removal sticker
- Scrap metal
- Shredded paper
- Tires\*



\* Limits apply

## Materials accepted - chargeable (cash, debit and credit accepted)

- Concrete
- Drywall\*
- Garbage
- Refrigerated appliances\*\*
- Wood\*
- Yard Waste (size restrictions apply)

## Fees

Loads of chargeable material	\$125 per tonne
Mixed loads of chargeable/ no charge material	\$125 per tonne minimum \$10
Loads up to 100kg	minimum \$10
Loads of no charge material only	\$0

### \*\*Refrigerated appliances

Residential/commercial without valid CFC removal sticker	\$20
Commercial with valid CFC removal sticker	\$10

## What is NOT accepted?

- Household hazardous waste from industrial, commercial or institutional sources
- Material containing polychlorinated biphenyls, (PCBs), ammunition, explosives, fireworks, flares and radioactive waste
- Sod, soil or clean fill

## How to avoid delays

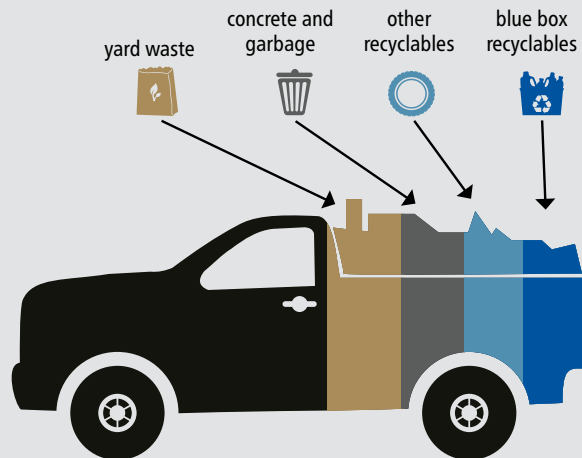
- Visit during non-peak times (Tuesday to Thursday)
- Visit alternative York Region waste depot sites such as:

- If available, consider purchasing bag tags for curbside collection of your extra garbage. Check with your local municipality for more details
- If you're bringing a mixed load including recyclables and garbage, consider bringing your recyclables one day and your chargeable materials on another

## What is accepted



## Follow the path

- 1 Drive to the scale
- 2 Drop off items
- 3 Pay and repeat

## 2 Unload

Drive to unloading area(s) and put waste materials in designated locations.



## 3 Exit transfer station

All vehicles are required to drive over the outbound scale, return their waste ticket and pay any applicable fees.

1. Have ticket and payment ready (cash, credit and debit accepted)
2. Approach scale on green light

## \$ Tip: Non-chargeable route

Drop off non-chargeable materials first (recyclables, e-waste, hazardous waste). You can then return for a second weigh-in to drop off chargeable materials.



## Route choices

- ➡➡➡ Chargeable / mixed materials
- ➡➡➡ Non-chargeable materials

## 1 Weigh-in and interview

Approach inbound scale on green light or as directed by staff. Stop on scale to be weighed. Speak to attendant and provide the following information:

1. City or Town you are from
  2. If you are a York Region resident or business
  3. Type of materials you are disposing (e.g. garbage, recyclables, yard waste, household hazardous waste, etc.)
- Fees will apply for loads containing any chargeable materials (dedicated or mixed). Customers with mixed loads have the option to circle the site twice if they do not wish to pay for non-chargeable materials
  - You will be issued a waste ticket by the scale attendant indicating the materials you have for drop off. The ticket will be reviewed before you can drop off your waste and upon exit

## Household hazardous waste

Household hazardous waste depot is open:

Tuesday 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Saturday 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

**Note:**  
Containers (including jerry cans) may not be returned.
