

# POSSIBLE EXPOSURE TO COVID-19

## COSTCO VAUGHAN, 71 COLOSSUS DRIVE, VAUGHAN, ONTARIO

### VARIOUS DATES BETWEEN APRIL 2, 2020 AND APRIL 23, 2020

York Region Public Health (YRPH) is investigating seven staff confirmed with COVID-19 who work at Costco Vaughan located at 71 Colossus Drive (Hwy 7 and Weston Road). We conducted risk assessments on the activities of these individuals while at work and determined the risk of COVID-19 transmission to the general public is low. We are completing the investigations of these COVID-19 confirmed cases and following up any close contacts that have been identified. In addition, we have conducted inspections at this location on three separate occasions over the past week to review and reinforce infection prevention and control measures, physical distancing of staff and customers and reaffirming the importance of staff not working while ill.

Costco staff and customers may be concerned about their possible exposure to COVID-19. The table below provides information to individuals who were shopping/working in Costco Vaughan on the dates when COVID-19 positive cases were at the Costco (refer to grey column below).

**COVID-19 Symptoms:** Fever, new or worsening cough, or new or worsening shortness of breath, muscle aches, fatigue, headache, sore throat, runny nose or diarrhea

**Close Contacts:** People you live with, have had intimate relationships with, people who have cared for you or you have cared for (for example, with bathing, feeding or dressing), or have come to your home. It also includes people you may have worked with and spent more than 10 minutes with them if they were not at least 2 metres (6 feet) away from you.
