Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Study

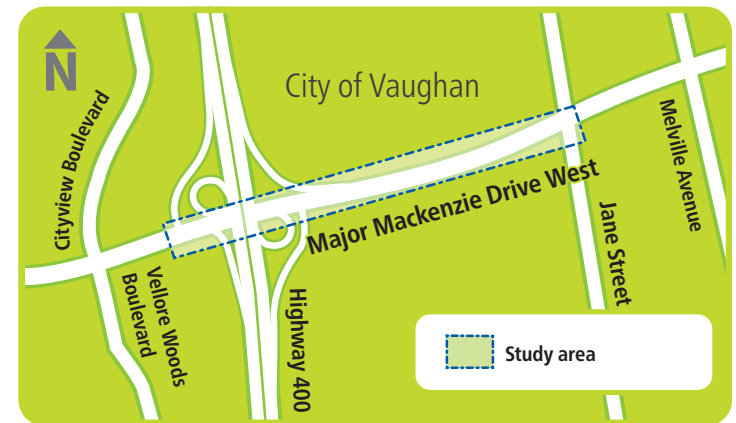
Major Mackenzie Drive West between Highway 400 and Jane Street

The Regional Municipality of York is conducting a Schedule 'C' Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) Study to review current and future transportation and infrastructure improvements on Major Mackenzie Drive West between Highway 400 and Jane Street in the City of Vaughan.

York Region will proceed with design and construction of the project following completion of the Class EA Study and has prepared an Environmental Study Report (ESR) documenting the study process, consultation efforts and recommended design plan.
