The Regional Municipality of York continues to plan for the future and is looking for your input and ideas. York Region is expected to grow to 1.79 million people and 900,000 jobs by 2041. To accommodate this growth and be at the forefront of best practices, York Region is reviewing and updating a number of its long-term strategic plans, including the Transportation Master Plan.

What is the **Transportation Master Plan**?

The Transportation Master Plan is York Region's blueprint to address the transportation and mobility needs of those living and working in York Region over the next 25 years. It guides planning and investing in the Region's transportation network, including Regional roads, York Region Transit (YRT/Viva), rapid transit (vivaNext), cycling and walking. It is shaped by provincial policy, Regional and local policies and stakeholder and public input.

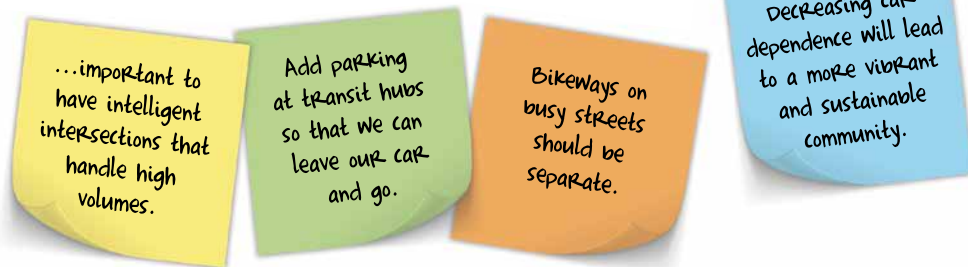
Fall Open House Update

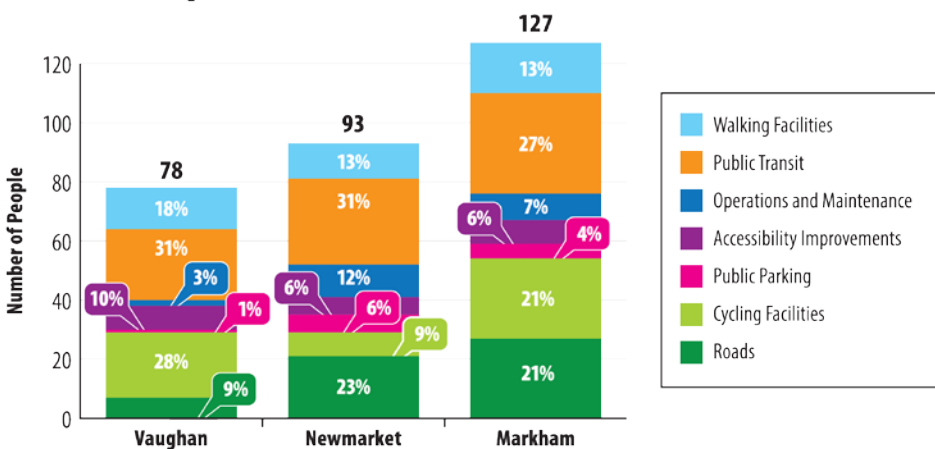
