Thank you for your patience as crews continue enhancing The Regional Municipality of York's Schomberg Water Treatment Plant (Plant), located at 210 Western Avenue. Work activities will continue as part of regular Plant operation until further notice. Crews will work inside and outside of the Plant as needed, Monday to Friday.

Please be advised that work activities at the facility do not affect your drinking water. Tap water in Schomberg continues to meet provincial drinking water quality standards and remains clean and safe to drink.

We understand construction can be disruptive to those who live, work and play in the area. That's why we have taken steps to reduce construction-related noise, light and dust where possible.


