

NOTICE OF COMMENCEMENT SANITARY SEWER EVALUATION

Town of Newmarket

The Regional Municipality of York and its Consultant (CIVICA), in partnership with the Town of Newmarket, are starting a project in your neighbourhood (see map) to help fix roof downspouts, sump pumps, foundation drains or other drains that are directly connected to the sanitary sewer. Monitoring shows that high amounts of rain water, melted snow and groundwater are entering the sewer system through these sources, called inflow and infiltration. High levels of inflow and infiltration put the sewer system at risk of backups, which can lead to basement flooding. It is also very costly to have what is mostly clean water sent to the wastewater treatment plant and taking up pipe capacity.

What is Next?

Commencing in April 2019, CIVICA will be in your area to answer any questions about the project and discuss whether you are interested in participating. If so, we will need your permission to evaluate your sewer connections. The evaluation will start with visual surveys inside and outside of your home, followed by fog and dye testing to confirm the sewer connections. Once the evaluation is complete, and if inflow and infiltration source(s) are identified, typical repair steps and details will be provided to you. If you choose to do the repairs, a list of contractors will be available to you. A CIVICA representative will explain the subsidy program application process during your visit. Approved work under our program will be eligible for a subsidy.
